ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree
- Complete and submit an application for admission with a \$40 nonrefundable admissions fee.
- Submit a statement of your interest in taking this program of study.
- Submit official transcripts of all previous colleges/institutions you have attended either in sealed, signed envelopes or via electronic submission directly from the registrar's office.
- Submit two letters of recommendation.
- Applicants will be requested to participate in an interview with a program faculty member

Option 1: Graduate Academic Certificate

For academic credit, this program is discounted for those in Catholic organizations and Mercy-supported works.

Option 2: Noncredit Certificate

Complete five courses and receive a certificate of completion. Each noncredit course is priced at a flat rate of \$410,* which includes tuition and fees.
